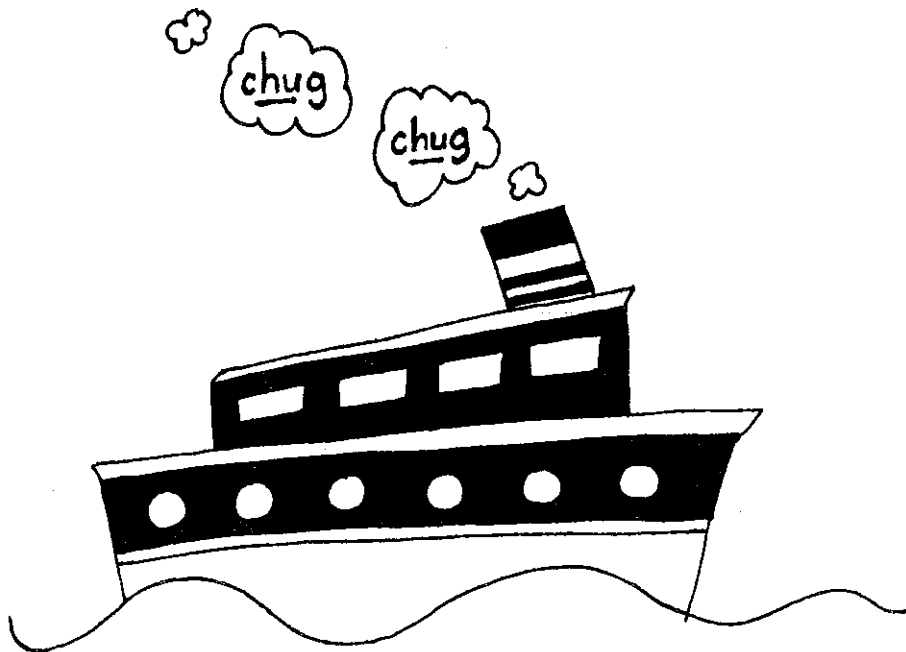
Ships at the Docks

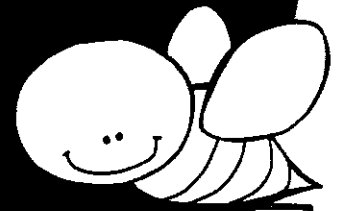
