It is nighttime in the summer.

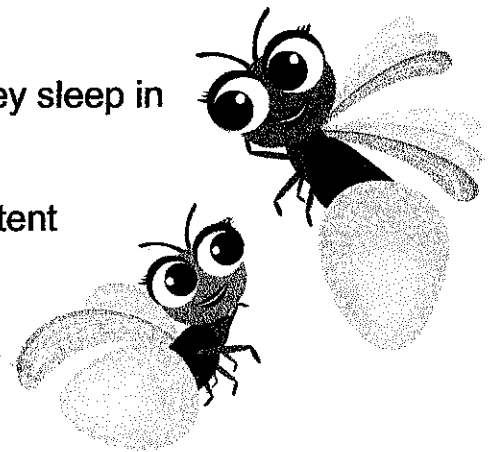

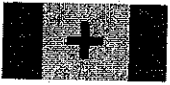

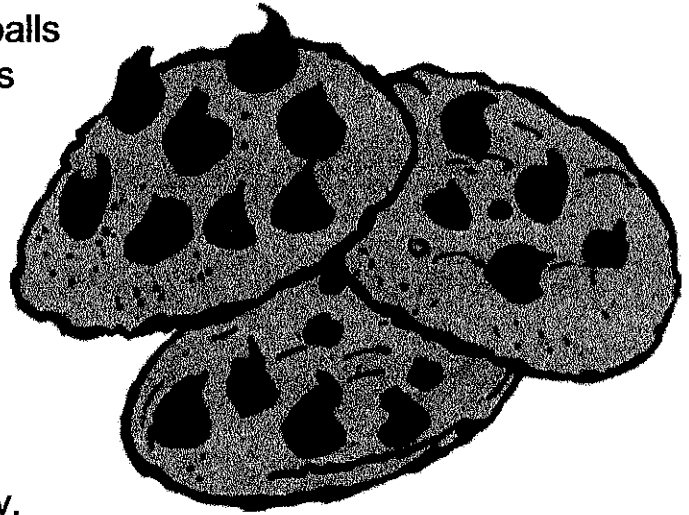
Making Cookies

There is a new water park in town. We go there on the first day of summer.

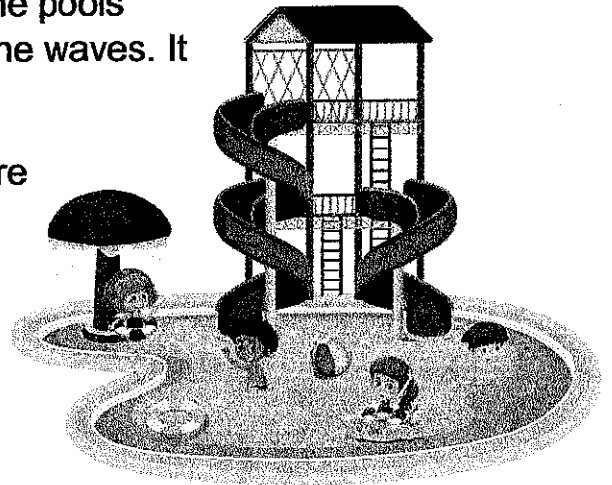
It has pools and water slides. There are sprinklers too. The slides are scary at first. After the first ride, we love the water slides.

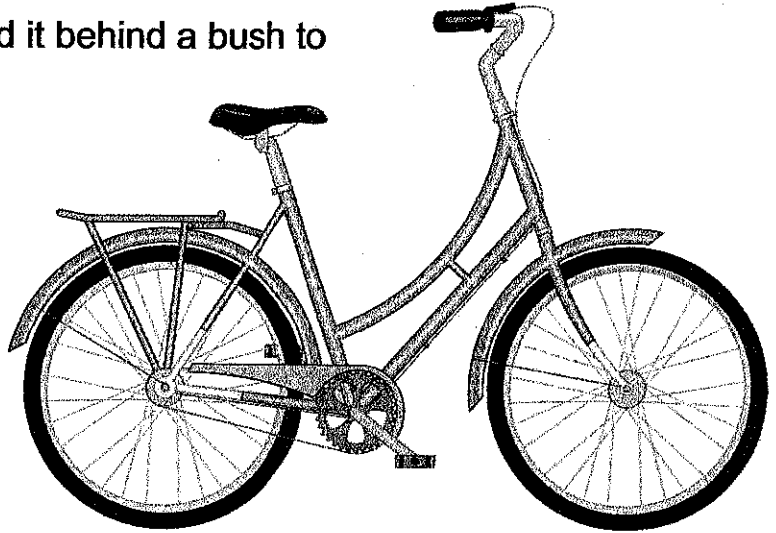
The New Bicycle

Peanuts and Popcorn

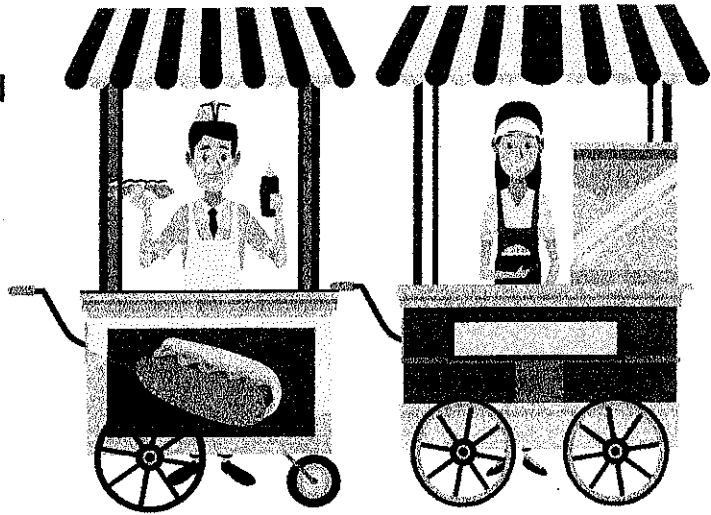
John is going to a baseball game with his aunt. He can't wait to get there. It is the first game of the season. The stadium is almost full.

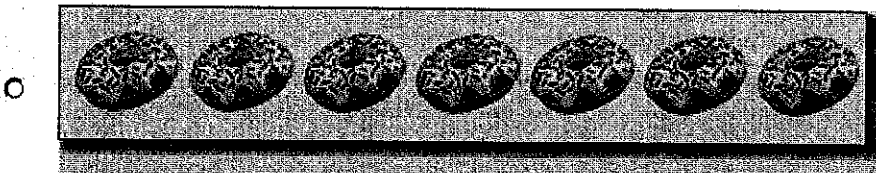

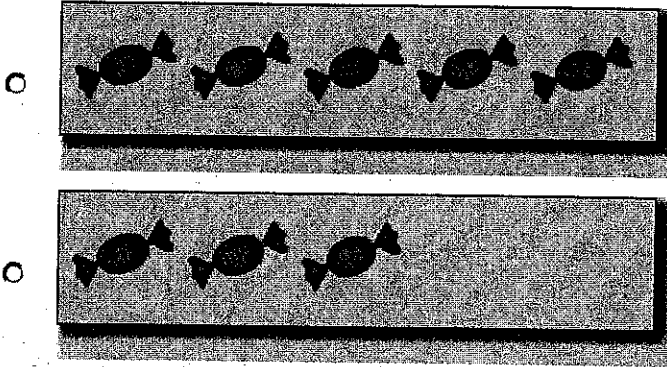

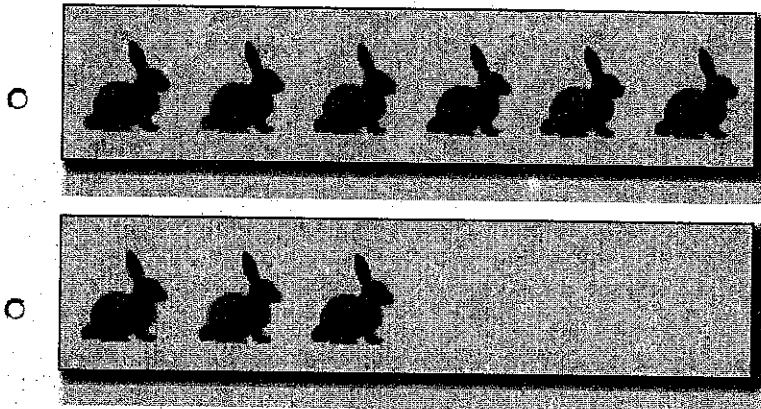

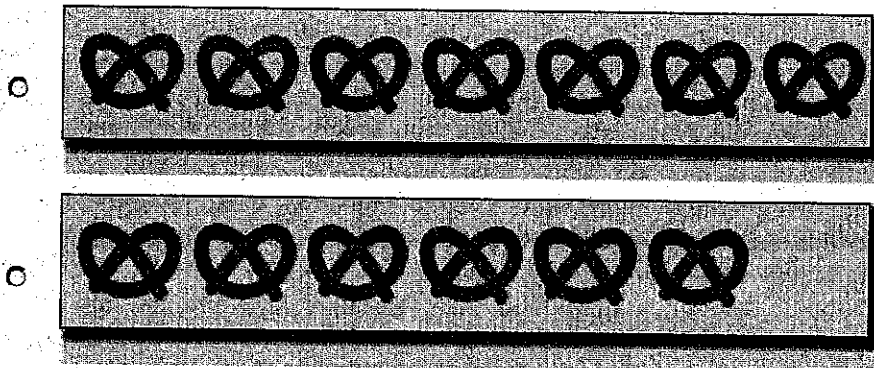

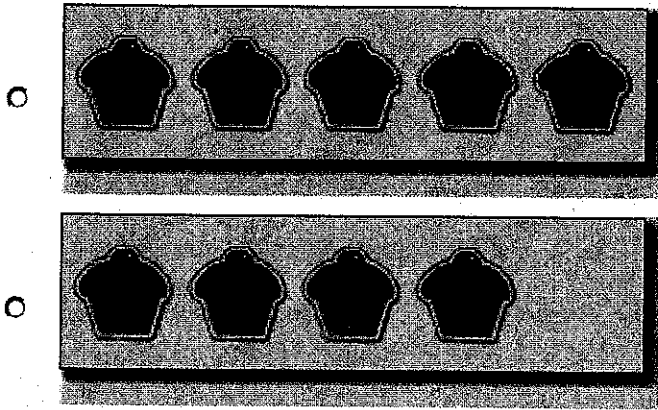

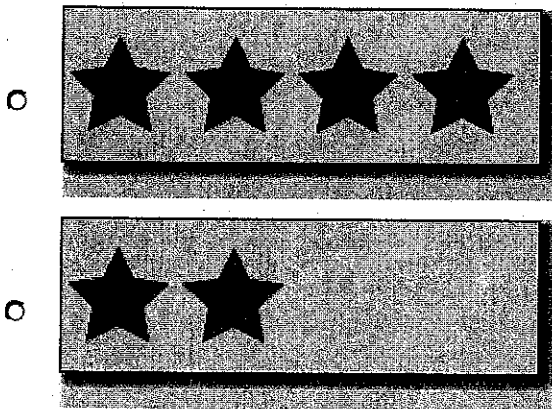
