- 4 ) Mary had 230 lynx stickers. Mary gave 58 stickers to Benny, 24 stickers to her sister and an additional 68 stickers to Fred. How many stickers does Mary still have? \_\_\_\_\_
- 5 ) Peter made 3 different stacks of wooden blocks. The first stack was 7 blocks high, the second stack was 6 block(s) higher than the first, and the final stack was 7 block(s) higher than the second. In total, how many blocks did Peter use for all 3 stacks? \_\_\_\_\_
- 6 ) For softball season, Fred decided to buy 31 balls, 34 pairs of shorts, as well as 21 pairs of softball shoes. In total, how many objects did Fred buy for softball season? \_\_\_\_\_
- 7 ) Benny wants several different color plates for his birthday. Benny wants to get 108 orange plates, 84 yellow plates, and some amount of black plates. In total, Benny wants 288 plates, so how many black plates should he get? \_\_\_\_\_
- 8 ) Before getting to school, Joan has a few errands to run. Joan has to walk 4 blocks to the museum, and 12 blocks to the store, before walking the final 9 blocks to arrive at school. If Joan has already walked 5 blocks, how many more blocks must she walk before arriving at school? \_\_\_\_\_
